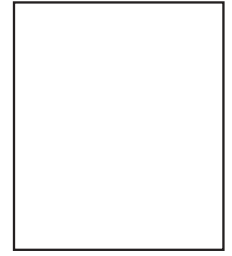

TERMS & CONDITIONS

General Rules & Regulations

- 1.1. Marvel badminton Sports center reserves the right to modify or amend the terms and conditions as deemed necessary.
- 1.2. The schedule for training sessions will be planned and organized by Marvel badminton Sports center.
- 1.3. Marvel badminton Sports center reserves the right to exclude any trainee/player from coaching sessions or training activities for violating the terms and conditions, or if they are deemed unfit for badminton, pose a danger to themselves or others, or exhibit inappropriate, abusive, or disruptive behavior.
- 1.4. Trainees/players and their parents will be responsible for any damages to Marvel Badminton Academy's facilities caused by negligence.
- 1.5. Marvel badminton Sports center reserves the right to use the name, images, voice, and words of trainees/players in television, radio, film, newspaper, magazine, website, social media, and other forms of media for communication purposes during and after their tenure.
- 1.6. Trainees/players are required to bring their own sports equipment (e.g., racquets, shoes).
- 1.7. If a trainee/player misses a session without prior notice, Marvel badminton Sports center is not obligated to provide compensation or makeup sessions. However, the coach may consider makeup sessions for valid reasons, which must be completed within the same payment month.
- 1.8. Parents wishing to communicate with the coach or management must make a prior appointment, ideally before or after training sessions.
- 1.9. To maintain focus and discipline, parents or guardians are requested to avoid entering the court area or interacting with trainees/players during training sessions.
- 1.10. Parents may observe their child's progress once a month, provided they submit a prior request.
- 1.11. If a trainee/player stops training for at least one month (31 days) without a valid reason or official notification via the academy's email (info@marvelbadminton.com), re-enrollment and registration, including a fee of QAR 100, will be required.
- 1.12. Trainees/players and parents may collect the coach's contact number for communication related to badminton sessions and progress. Personal communication with coaches is strictly prohibited.

Fees & Payment Policy

- 2.1. A one-time fee is required for each player/trainee's enrollment or re-enrollment.
- 2.2. Training session fees must be paid in full on a monthly basis by the 3rd of each month, regardless of attendance. All sessions must be completed within the payment month. Carrying sessions forward, replacements, or refunds are not permitted.
- 2.3. Partial fee payment is not allowed. Trainees with incomplete attendance for a month, without valid reason and official notice via the academy email (info@marvelbadminton.com), must still pay the full monthly fee. This does not apply to new enrollments.
- 2.4. All payments must be made via card to Marvel badminton Sports center.
- 2.5. All payments must be made in Qatari Riyals (QAR).

Tournaments Policy

- 3.1. Tournament selection and entries for trainees/players are the responsibility of Marvel Badminton Academy and should not be handled by trainees/players or parents at any time. Please contact the coach or management of Marvel badminton Sports center for such matters.
- 3.2. Tournament entries, number of categories, partner selection, and uniform/dress code will be decided by the coach or management of Marvel badminton Sports center.
- 3.3. It is mandatory for all trainees/players to wear the Marvel badminton Sports center uniform during all tournaments, including the prize distribution ceremony. (Uniforms are available for purchase at a minimal cost).
- 3.4. Marvel badminton Sports center will make every effort to assign a coach to be present during tournaments. Only coaches are permitted to engage in discussions with trainees/players during matches.
- 3.5. Players/trainees/parents are responsible for any applicable fees and expenses for tournament participation inside or outside Qatar. Marvel badminton Sports center may, at its discretion, choose to sponsor part or all of these fees and expenses.
- 3.6. When a trainee/player wins a tournament, Marvel badminton Sports center will promote or post the victory announcement across multiple channels (newspapers, social media, etc.). Trainees/players/parents must not independently create, promote, or post announcements without the consent of Marvel badminton Sports center.

Dress Code Policy

- 4.1. Trainees/players must wear proper badminton attire and shoes during training sessions at all times.
- 4.2. Boys/Gents: Sports shorts and T-shirts.
- 4.3. Girls/Ladies: Sports skirts, shorts, tights, and T-shirts.
- 4.4. Footwear: Non-marking badminton shoes and sports socks.

Medical Emergency & Non-Emergency Policy

- 5.1. In the event of a medical emergency during any activity, Marvel badminton Sports center will take necessary measures to ensure the trainee/player/student receives hospitalization.
- 5.2. In non-emergency medical situations during any activity, Marvel badminton Sports center will provide basic first aid such as icing, pain relief spray, stretching, etc.
